

What is Intergenerational Trauma?

In Canada, the Residential School system resulted in many years of trauma for generations of Indigenous people. This trauma has had long-lasting effects. Over time the impact of this trauma can be seen in survivors, their children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren. This is called intergenerational trauma.

TRAUMA

A lasting emotional response from something, usually impactful and often negative, that has occurred.

INTERGENERATIONAL TRAUMA

Intergenerational trauma is devastating to Indigenous people because the situation was very different.

Many people go through traumatic experiences, however, with Indigenous people in Canada it was largely an entire ethnic group of people, as almost every Indigenous person in Canada is a child or grandchild of a residential school survivor.

That means that intergenerational trauma is effecting the majority of Indigenous people.
